Our volunteer program primarily aims at preserving the natural life patterns of French Polynesian cetacean populations. As part of our **Ceta'Diving mission**, you will learn to identify Rangiroa dolphins at the individual scale and to better understand their behaviors in the context of their interactions with scuba diving tourism. **The mission is opened to certified scuba divers.**
